


Care Sector Christmas Lunch 2024

Right now, almost 1 in 3 children in the UK live in poverty because too many families are struggling to make ends meet. Thanks to the generosity of the Championing Social Care Community, Barnardo's can make sure families get the support they need—whether it's helping them put food on the table, keeping the electricity on so they can stay warm, or organising special days out for them to enjoy as a family. The Care Sector Christmas Lunch raised close to £32,000 for Barnardo's, which is truly incredible. To give you a sense of the direct impact this will have:

Transforming Lives: The Impact of Your Generosity

£2,000 can help keep eight families well-fed for a whole month. You could relieve huge financial strain, and make sure children go to school having had breakfast and have a hot meal waiting for them when they come home.

£10,000 can buy a school uniform and shoes for 200 children, allowing them to feel proud of their appearance.

£20,000 can provide vital support for over 100 households, equating to nearly 400 people and including 250 children.

This would include purchasing food (and appliances needed to prepare hot meals) and suitable clothing (including school uniforms), and provision of access to warm spaces throughout
