HOW IT WORKS

1

Engaging with students

We will bring together 500 students at a prestigious venue for a full day of learning, sharing and personal growth.

Sessions will be led by experienced speakers, with a strong emphasis on stories from those who have 'been there and done it'.

2

Access to recruiters

Care providers and recruitment specialists will have interactive stalls and lead sessions that will give students direct advice on applying for and working in the sector.

3

Post-event

We will provide teachers with the materials to support learning in their own schools and colleges.

We will also use the event to start to build an idea of students' movement into the sector, following the progression of attendees who take up roles and start to build careers within the care sector.

GROWING THE IMPACT OF WHO CARES WINS

We will grow the impact of **'Who Care Wins'** by building a lasting relationship with the students who attend - monitoring changes in their attitude to working in care.

Working with research partners will enable us to track and deliver high quality analysis over a period of time.



WHAT ELSE WILL WE DO?

Our mission is to make **Who Cares Wins** a nationally renowned programme, that supports the growth of the care sector's future workforce.

In time, we want to create the capacity to take our message 'on the road' by creating materials that others can use; by partnering with organisations that hold similar events and have similar aims; and potentially by holding versions of the WCW event across the country.



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
